	1 Sleeping Bag	Mummy style is warmer than Rectangular
	1 Pillow	
	1 Light Sheet or Fleece Liner	keeps your bag clean & warmer
	1 Ground Pad or extra blanket	lays under sleeping bag - the ground is cold!
	1 sleeping cap	stocking cap - keeps your feet warm
	PP Toilet Kit	tooth brush/tooth paste appreciated!
	IN Swim Suit	Seasonal item
	IN Bath Towels	Seasonal item
	IN Sandals	Seasonal item for showers/not activities
	2 or 3 Socks	Fresh pair for each day plus 1 extra
	2 of 3 Underwear	Fresh pair for each day plus 1 extra
	2 or 3 Scout T-Shirts	Fresh for each day plus 1 extra
	1 or 2 Field Dress (Class A) Uniform Shirt	For ALL Travel plus assemblies
	2 pair Shoes - Outdoor Type, incl sturdy sneakers or light trail boots	Not your best basketball or socker shoes!
	2 Bread Bags	Cheap waterproof liners for between wet shoes and dry socks
	1 or 2 Pants/Shorts	May want to change
	1 Scout Cap	avoid Sunburn/Bugs/Branches
	1 Eating Utensils (Fork, Knife, Spoon or SPORK)	convenience for meals
	1 Cup - insulated mug is good for hot cocoa	good for hot OR cold drinks. Not too big.
	1 Plate or Bowl	nothing fancy needed - cheap and simple
	1 Camp Chair	great for campfire time
	1 Day Pack	good place for swim shoes and towel
	1 Fanny Pack - OPTIONAL	good place to keep your canteen & 1st aide kit
	1 Scout Handbook	ALWAYS!
	AR Merit Badge Books	Ones you are working on
	AR Special Materials for Merit Badge work	Review with Scout Leaders before campout
	1 Wind Breaker/Jacket	combine w/rain gear to save weight!
	1 Rain Gear - waterproof jacket or poncho	jacket/pants combo recommended
	1 Warm Sweatshirt or Fleece Sweater	warm as a coat used under/with the jacket
	1 Water Bottle/Canteen	1 liter or smaller, so its easy to carry
	1 Totin' Chip Card (if earned)	
	1 Pocket Knife	if you have your Totin Chip
	1 Flash Light	small LED's are really battery thrifty
	AR Extra Batteries	at LEAST one set
	1 Paper/Pad/Notebook
